UVA Health Children's is Virginia's leading provider of neonatal and pediatric intensive care and a top referral center for pediatric traumas, cardiac cases, critical care, and complex surgeries across the Southeast.

Families across the commonwealth turn to UVA Health Children's for life-saving care of their loved ones from birth to 18 years old. Growing demand for our acclaimed neonatal and pediatric intensive care units (NICU and PICU) means we are nearly always at capacity. Too often we're unable to admit critically ill infants or children due to lack of space (on average 10 babies and up to 24% of pediatric patients per month). To continue providing the best possible care to our community, UVA Health Children's has launched a **\$50 million** project with a **\$25 million philanthropic goal** to expand and enhance the NICU and PICU.

This project will enable us to increase the **number of NICU and PICU beds**, equip all beds with vital, **state-of-the-art technology**, and provide more single rooms and **spaces for patient-family bonding**, which have been shown to improve patient outcomes and reduce lengths of stay. UVA Health Children's is consistently ranked the #1 children's hospital in Virginia, with 8 specialties among the top 50 in the nation, including our #26 neonatology program. As the primary destination for the most serious and complex cases in the commonwealth and beyond, we must continually elevate our technology and expand access to our world-class NICU and PICU.

NEONATAL INTENSIVE CARE

- Provides around-the-clock care of premature and critically ill newborns, including at-risk babies delivered at UVA's Maternal and Fetal Medicine Clinic (850 babies admitted annually)
- Home to Virginia's only ONLY Neuro-Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, specializing in infant brain injuries and neurologic anomalies and diseases
- Uses a UVA-pioneered predictive modeling system (HeRO) for advanced patient monitoring and medical risks assessment

PEDIATRIC INTENSIVE CARE

- Serves 1,000 patients per year with serious injuries and medical concerns, including organ transplants, traumatic brain injuries, kidney failure, and more
- Performs over 50% of Virginia's pediatric heart surgeries and most complex procedures as nation's #33 pediatric cardiology program
- Provides advanced patient monitoring and risks assessment through predictive modeling software (CoMET)
